**Who Drinks Mocktails on the Beach?!** premieres as part of the Montreal Fringe Festival at the **Mainline Theatre from July 6-16th. Told in the style of Phoebe Waller-Bridge’s Fleabag** with an early 2000’s pop-punk soundtrack, this one-woman comedy follows party-girl Candace as she runs away to Mexico for her best friend’s destination wedding. A karaoke bar, dead goldfish, a failed threesome, and a spirited adventure awaits! You won’t have regrets... but Candace might.

This play is written and performed by Sara Mayfield, directed by Damon Bradley Jang\*, stage managed by Charlene Bayer, and developed as part of Playwriting 102 with the Arts Club Theatre Company. This play is produced by Painted Fern Productions, with presenting sponsor Fabulist Theatre.

Based in Vancouver, BC, **Painted Fern Productions’ previous show, The Girl Next Door**, a new queer pop/rock musical co-written by Sara Mayfield and Ava Maria Safai, **won 9 regional Broadway World awards, and an Ovation Award nomination for Outstanding New Work.** Sara Mayfield is the Artistic Director of Painted Fern Productions, and has worked with companies like The Vancouver Opera, UK based dance company Sirencrossings, and Montreal based Shakespeare Canada. Damon Bradley Jang\* is a recent Stratford Festival Company member, the Co-Artistic and Marketing Director of Fabulist Theatre and holds a Bachelor of Performing arts and Musical Theatre diploma from Capilano University.
